

Hereford cattle arrived in the United States in 1817 to serve a similar need — efficiently adding pounds to native cattle grazing the nation's rangelands, while also creating reproductively efficient females. American Hereford breeders founded the Hereford Cattle Breeders Association in 1881, which was later renamed the American Hereford Association (AHA). The Hereford breed and AHA maintain the original vision — build more pounds of quality beef and more production-efficient females with fewer resources than otherwise possible, via the breed's inherent genetic advantages.

The World Hereford Conference attracts progressive cattlemen and women seeking the latest information, genetics and technology the industry has to offer. In 2025, the American Hereford Association's (AHA) Annual Membership Meeting will be held in conjunction with the World Hereford Conference bringing together two elite conferences.
